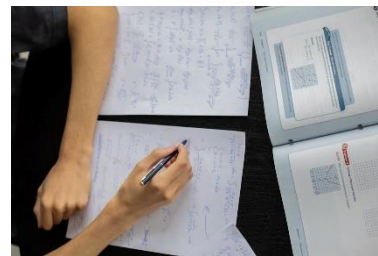

Staycation is a two-day event that includes quilting on your projects, games, classes, a fabric sale (\$1 a yard), and lots of food. You have the option of participating in none, some, or all of the activities—it is all up to you.

The clubhouse is very secure, so you can leave your machine on Friday night and return on Saturday, repeating the process of sewing, eating, and having fun starting at 9:30 a.m. Space is limited, so bring your machine and sewing project, but leave the excess in your car. We will have ironing and cutting stations set up for your use.

We will also be holding a small quilt swap:

2024 Staycation Small Quilt Swap

The swap will be held following our General Meeting at Staycation. All entries will receive a special “Thank You” gift. This means even members who are not attending Staycation but are going to the General Meeting can participate.

Here are the rules:

1. Make a small quilt with something that starts with the letter of your LAST name somewhere on the quilt. Using Jane Doe’s name as an example, she could use Daisy fabric or put a Dog on her quilt; now, if she thinks outside the box, she could make her quilt the shape of a Diamond. I think you get the idea...let your imagination run wild. Please, NO HOLIDAY-themed quilts...not everyone celebrates the same holidays.
2. Your small quilt can be any shape, as long as the outer dimensions are no smaller than 72” and no bigger than 96”. For example, an 18x18-square small quilt will equal 72”, and a 24x24-square quilt will equal 96”.
3. Front-batting-backing, quilted, and edges bound
4. Your quilt must have a Label on the back and needs to include:

a. Title of the Swap: 2024 Staycation Small **Quilt Swap**

b. **“Last Letter of Your Name” is for**

c. **Your Name**

For example:

“D” is for Dog

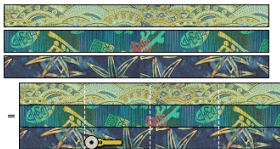
FOUR PART STRIP BLOCK

This makes a 12" block, and is part of the "Rail Fence Family". In the case of this block it's all about Location-Location-Location of the colors within the blocks--darks in the "center wheel, then mediums, then lights on the outside!"

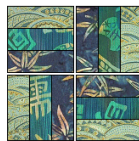

** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



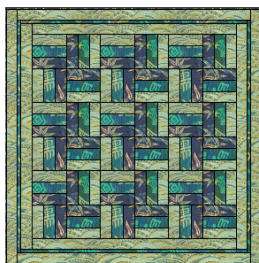
Sew the Color 1, Color 2 and Color 3 strips right sides together along the long edges as shown at left, using a scant 1/4" seam allowance, then press the seams to one side. Cut this pieced unit at 6-1/2" intervals...



Then rotate the squares so that they lay out like the picture at left. Sew two horizontal rows, alternating pressing direction by row. Join the two rows and you have finished your block! ...[on to Page 2!](#)

** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



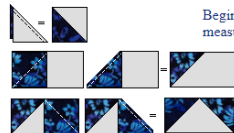
Let's begin by stacking, marking and cutting the Color 1 and Color 2 3-7/8" x 15-1/2" strips into four 3-7/8" squares. Then cut the Color 1 3-1/2" x 28" strip into eight 3-1/2" squares...



Cut the Color 1 and Color 2 3-7/8" squares on the diagonals to make eight half square triangles of each...



Then cut your Color 2 3-1/2" x 26" strip into four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...



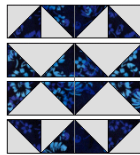
Begin by stacking, edges aligned, a Color 2 and a Color 1 half square triangle. Sew, using a SCANT 1/4" seam. Press seam allowances towards your darker fabric. Make eight of these units. Trim to measure 3-1/2" if needed...

Then, place your Color 1 3-1/2" squares atop a Color 2 rectangle, with edges aligned and right sides together. Mark a diagonal line on the back of the Color 1 square. Sew along this line, cut off the excess. Press seam towards darker fabric..

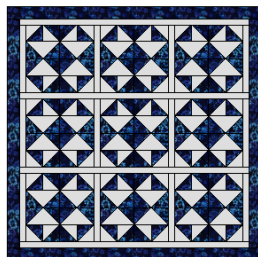
Then repeat the above with another square on the other corner of the Color 2 rectangles. Make four of these units...on to [Page 2!](#)

Now piece the block! Make rows first...row one is made of four half squares...row two equals two of the rectangle units, as does row three...and then row four is made of the remaining half squares...refer to diagram for placement! Lastly...sew your rows together...and press row seams in alternating directions...



Here are three blocks by three with sashings and a simple border!
