Meeting opened at 9:35 AM

Treasurer's report: combined accounts total \$13,702.08. It was moved by Kat Rahla and 2nd by Michelle Kay that the treasurer's report be accepted as given. Motion passed.

Minutes: it was moved by Jackie Blazok and 2nd by Kathy Battaglia that the minutes be accepted as written. Motion passed.



2024 Staycation Small Quilt Swap

2024 Staycation is a two-day event. To show off our talents, we thought we would hold another Small Quilt Swap. The swap will be held following our General Meeting at Staycation. This means even members not attending the Staycation but going to the General Meeting can participate.

Here are the rules:

- 1. Make a small quilt with something that starts with the letter of your LAST name somewhere on the quilt. Using Jane Doe's name as an example, she could use Daisy fabric, or she could put a Dog or her quilt, now if she really thinks outside the box, she could make her quilt the shape of a Diamond. I think you get the idea...let your imagination run wild. Please, NO HOLIDAY-themed quilts...not everyone celebrates the same holidays.
- 2. Your small quilt can be any shape, as long as the outer dimensions are no smaller than 72" and no bigger than 96". For example, an 18x18-square small quilt will equal 72", and a 24x24-square quilt will equal 96".
- 3. Front-batting-backing, quilted, and edges bound
- 4. Your quilt must have a Label on the back and needs to include:
- a. Title of the Swap: 2024 Staycation Small Quilt Swap
- b. "Last Letter of Your Name" is for
- c. Your NameFor example:2024 Staycation Small Quilt Swap"D" is for DogJane Doe



### **FABRIC COLOR CHOICES FOR LOVER'S KNOT: LAVENDERS AND PURPLES:**

Lover's Rnot


Similar in appearance to Churn Dash...this version of a Lover's Knot Block is a very easy one to make! It's a 12" block!

\*\* Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block \*\* First cut the Color 1 2-1/2" x 14" strip into four 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles...


Next cut the Color 3 2-1/2" x 10" strip into four 2-1/2" squares...



Now speed piece the half squares by stacking the Color 1 and Color 2 5-7/8" x 11-3/4" strips right sides together. On the back of the top strip lightly mark the diagonals and the 5-7/8" square line, and sew a scant 1/4" above and below the diagonal lines. Cut apart on the marked diagonals, and on the square line. Presseam allowances towards the darker fabric. This will give you four half squares. Trim these back to measure 5-1/2" if needed...



Next sew a Color 3 2-1/2" square to one end of each Color 1 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.



Sew one of the rectangle strips to the right side of a large half square, referring to the diagram at left for orientation of the pieces. Add another half square to the other side of the rectangle strip. Press seam allowances towards the center strip. Make two of these units.



Now sew the extra Color 1  $\,$  2-1/2" square between the last two rectangle units. Press seam allowances towards the outer rectangles  $\,$  ... on Page 2!

Piece the state of the state of

Lover's Knot - Page 2

Piece the block in the order shown at left, alternating pressing directions as you add rows.

Here's a simple quilt, with sashing around the blocks, two thin borders strips, and a narrow bin

Now speed piece the half squares by stacking the Color 1 and Color 2 5-7/8" x 11-3/4" strips right sides together. On the back of the top strip lightly mark the diagonals and the 5-7/8" square line, and sew a scant 1/4" above and below the diagonal lines. Cut apart on the marked diagonals, and on the square line. Press seam allowances towards the darker fabric. This will give you four half squares. Trim these back to measure 5-1/2" if needed...

**10** 30 = **10** 50 30

Next sew a Color 3  $\,$  2-1/2" square to one end of each Color 1  $\,$  2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.



Sew one of the rectangle strips to the right side of a large half square, referring to the diagram at left for orientation of the pieces. Add another half square to the other side of the rectangle strip. Press seam allowances towards the center strip. Make two of these units...



Now sew the extra Color 1 2-1/2" square between the last two rectangle units. Press seam allowances towards the outer rectangles ...on 1 Page 2!
